HOW TO IMPRESS AT A SCHOLARSHIP INTERVIEW

ttending any type of interview is one of the most nerve-wracking moments in anyone's life but if you prepare well there's no need to worry.

If you follow this advice you'll be equipped to excel and leave the interview knowing you did everything possible to make a good impression and secure the scholarship.

PREPARE THOROUGHLY It goes without saying that

ahead of the scholarship

interview you need to prepare as thoroughly as possible. Read up about the company, imagine the questions you might be faced with and think about questions you'd like to ask.

Five of the most common interview questions include: Tell us about yourself; Why do you want this scholarship? What would you bring to this company? What are your strengths and weaknesses? What do you plan to be doing in five vears?

Ask a friend or family member to pretend to be the interviewer so you can practice your answers and get them clear in your head, which will also help to calm any nerves.

If possible, contact someone who has already undertaken a scholarship and ask them for advice on how they approached the interview and questions on what the scholarship involved and what they are doing now

GET SOME REST ^zz

This might seem obvious but the evening and night before the interview you should make sure you get plenty of rest so that your body and mind are prepared and you're fully alert the next day.

If nerves keep you awake, try listening to some music or reading a book, until you naturally drift off to sleep.

EAT WELL



Studies have shown a good breakfast is essential to boost energy as well as concentration levels, so

make sure you eat well before the interview, whether it's scheduled for the morning or afternoon.

The last thing you want is a growling stomach to distract you and the interviewers!

STAY CALM Try to keep any nervous



energy in check by reminding yourself that because you've been

called for interview, you must meet the scholarship criteria, and the

interview is just a chance for the company to get to know you better.

Out of hundreds, or maybe even thousands of applicants, they have chosen to interview you, which should be a confidence booster.



DRESS TO IMPRESS

Wear a suit or other appropriate smart clothing to demonstrate your professionalism.

Most recruitment experts suggest arriving about 10-15 minutes before the interview time which will also give you plenty of time to check your appearance in the bathroom.

Make eye contact with everyone you are introduced to, be friendly and smile, and when shaking hands try to ensure that your greeting isn't too limp or hard.

BE ENTHUSIASTIC

The interview itself is your time to shine. Make sure the

interviewer knows that you want the scholarship and are enthusiastic about the area of study. Show how interested you are in the company by sitting up straight, being attentive and speaking clearly.

Remember this is your chance to sell yourself and leave the interviewers with no doubt that you are ready for this opportunity and will make the most of it.

Life can change in the blink of an eye, so appreciate what you have while you still have it, and while you're working towards making it better.




history, tomorrow is a mystery, today is a gift of God, which is why we

When you concentrate on the present, you have less time to feel sad about the past, or fret about the future.




concentrate on the ups rather than the downs, you'll instantly feel positive about almost everything.





Local Scholarships

Application Period: 1 March 2024 - 30 April 2024

The local scholarship can facilitate a Fall 2024 or Spring 2025 start date at UCCI, ICCI, UWI Open Campus, Truman Bodden Law School, St. Matthew's University, A levels, BTEC Level 3 or the final year of CAPE, International Baccalaureate or Advanced Placement.

Those Year 11 JGHS, CHHS and LSHS students wanting to pursue A Level, CAPE, BTEC Level 3, International Baccalaureate or Advanced Placement studies ONLY beginning Fall 2023, must also complete this application process.

Overseas Scholarships

How do I apply for a local or overseas Government Educational scholarship?

You can apply for a local or overseas scholarship by going to the Scholarship webpage at moescholarships.gov.ky. The entire application process is online and you will be required to complete an online application together with uploading other supporting documentation. You should use the guidance notes available on the website or contact the Scholarship Secretariat for guidance by email: scholarships@gov.ky.

What are the academic criteria required to qualify for a Government Educational Scholarship?

The academic criteria for the various local and overseas scholarships are provided on the website. The overseas academic criteria are each listed as standalone documents for each scholarship while the local academic criteria are included in the specific application forms. Additional information is also available in the guidance notes in the relevant sections.

Is there a minimum and maximum age requirement for a scholarship?

There is a minimum age requirement that all applicants must be at least 17 years old by September 1st at the start of their studies. There is no maximum age restriction.

I don't have my final results yet. Can I still apply for a scholarship?

Yes, you can and should apply for the scholarship - both local and overseas while you await your final examinations and final results. You can be conditionally approved pending final results. If you have any questions about this please contact the Scholarship Secretariat Unit at email: scholarships@gov.ky.

What are the deadlines for the submission of application forms?

The Overseas scholarship application period is 15th Nov - 31st Jan annually. The Local Scholarship application period is 1st March - 30th April annually.

Am I able to apply for a scholarship to pursue online studies?

Yes, the Government Educational Scholarships are available to pursue online studies at the local undergraduate level at ICCI and the UWI Open Campus. Online study with an overseas institution is only available at the post-graduate degree level (i.e. Masters level or higher). Please note: you do not have to complete a medical if you are doing postgraduate studies online.

Does my acceptance at a local or overseas institution guarantee the award of a

scholarship?

No, acceptance into a university locally or overseas does not guarantee the award of a scholarship. It forms part of the requirements but other criteria must also be met including but not limited to academics. If you are in doubt please contact the Scholarship Secretariat at email: scholarships@gov.ky.

What do I have to do to maintain my local or overseas scholarship?

Both local and overseas undergraduate scholarship recipients are required to achieve a semester GPA of 2.75 (US) / 2:2 (UK) or higher during their first year of studies whether locally or overseas and a semester GPA of 3.0 (US) / 2:1 (UK) or higher during subsequent years of study. Post-graduate scholarship recipients are to achieve a semester GPA of 3.0 (US) / 2:1 (UK) throughout their studies. A' Level students are required to achieve grades C, C, C in 3 out of 4 AS subjects taken in the 1st year to continue funding into their 2nd year of studies.

Are scholarship opportunities available to persons who have Special Education Needs and wish to pursue tertiary education?

There are provisions available to accommodate high school graduates with Special Education Needs and applicants are encouraged to communicate with the Secretariat about these opportunities (email: scholarships@gov.ky).

Are there special considerations for student athletes who represent the Cayman Islands?

Yes, students who continue their athletic training while on scholarship can qualify for adjusted academic requirements as long as they provide ongoing proof of their athlete status. For further details email: scholarships@ gov.ky.

Is career and tertiary education guidance available to me if I am unsure of the postsecondary opportunities available to me?

Yes, the Scholarship Secretariat does offer career and tertiary education guidance to anyone needing assistance. Continued support is offered to scholarship awardees during their post-secondary and tertiary experience. To set up an appointment, send an email with particulars to scholarships@gov.ky.

Are local and overseas scholarship opportunities available to mature candidates?

Yes, both local and overseas scholarship opportunities are available to mature persons who are encourage to contact the Scholarship Secretariat by email: scholarships@gov.ky.

Can I be approved to pursue a foundation year at the beginning of my course of study?

The Government Educational Scholarship does not fund the foundation year as this year does not contribute to the degree. It is a pre-qualification year that, on completion, allows the student to gain acceptance to Year 1 of the degree programme. If you have further questions on this, email: scholarships@gov.ky.

How much is the overseas scholarship award?

Overseas undergraduate studies are funded up to \$30,000 KYD per annum for up to four years. Overseas postgraduate studies are funded up to \$35,000 KYD per annum for up to two years for masters studies, and up to three years for doctoral studies. Funds are disbursed to the student in two equal payments - fall (August/September) and spring (December/January) for on campus studies. Different protocols apply for online studies. For specific situations, email: scholarships@gov.ky.

How much is the local scholarship award?

Local scholarship amount varies per scholarship, per level, and per institution. You can email scholarships@gov. ky to receive information specific to the area of interest. However, the funds are paid to the institutions directly and not to the individual students.

Can I receive a scholarship for another degree at the same level?

No, scholarships are not approved for persons at the same level of study that they have already attained, whether or not the qualifications were funded by the Cayman Islands Government.

Can I defer my studies?

Yes, you can defer your studies for up to one year from the scholarship award. If you are already enrolled in the course of study, you must provide approval from the institution and as well as an explanation with supporting documentation for your decision to defer.

Who approves the application for the Government Educational Scholarship?

The Education Council who is appointed by the Minister of Education, reviews, approves or declines all applications against the criteria outlined in the Education Council Policy & Procedures Guide.

Am I expected to return to the Cayman Islands when I have completed my studies?

Yes, your scholarship award includes an agreement that you are bonded to return to the Cayman Islands for the length of time of the scholarship award. Failure to do so can result in the request for repayment of the full sums awarded. You can request to defer your bond for up to three years from completion – this will need to be approved by Education Council.

What can I do as an applicant to help the process run as smoothly and quickly as possible?

You can ensure that you complete the application as directed and that you provide all required documents including updated information in a timely fashion during all aspects of the scholarship from applying for to maintaining your scholarship.

THE DO'S AND DON'TS WHEN APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

 ompetition to win a scholarship is tougher than ever as more students are applying for these prestigious
and highly sought-after awards.

First and foremost, you need to make an impression on paper and then you've got to dazzle in person at an interview.

You cannot afford to blow either of these opportunities, especially through your negligence and carelessness by not paying attention to details.

What makes some students stand out more than others?

HERE ARE SOME TIPS ON STAYING AHEAD:



DO NOT PROCRASTINATE! Get a head start

- start doing your research early, don't wait until the last minute and rush your application.



DO YOUR RESEARCH. Are you qualified for the scholarship

you are applying for? Don't waste your time or the receiving scholarship committee's time, if you don't qualify. Take your time to research which scholarships you are eligible to apply for and if the scholarships are limited to a specific university.



SLOW DOWN, DO NOT RUSH THE PROCESS. Read instructions

carefully - once, twice, three times. Check the requirements - writing an essay, completing a form, a combination of both, submitting references. If you're unsure, ask a teacher or counselor.

DO READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. Ensure you understand what the business/institution awarding the scholarship expects from you and follow those instructions precisely.





THAT YOU PROOFREAD YOUR APPLICATION FORM BEFORE

DO ENSURE

SUBMISSION. Check your spelling - your application represents you on paper, which means it reflects who you are. Careless spelling errors make you appear sloppy. Pay close attention to detail. Ask a friend, parent, teacher to proofread the final version of your application form.



DO NOT LEAVE BOXES BLANK. Be thorough answer every question, and

don't leave any boxes blank. This could cost you dearly and may result in not being invited for an interview.



DO INCLUDE AS MUCH RELEVANT INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE. Relevance

- include all valuable relevant information about your experience, your interests, and goals, which are compatible with the scholarship on offer.



DO NOT BE AFRAID TO SELL YOURSELF. Highlight your strengths and

accomplishments, most of all – be yourself, honest and open.



DO INCLUDE REFERENCES. Ask people who know you well to write letters of

recommendation. Request that they clearly reveal in what capacity they know you.

DO NOT ASK IMPERTINENT QUESTIONS. If a scholarship stipulates

attendance at a specific university, do not ask if you can attend an alternative university. There is a reason as to why this particular university has been selected. It is disrespectful to ask for a change of location if it doesn't appeal to you.



DO BE PATIENT. The selection process takes time. Wait patiently to be invited for an interview!

STUDENT VISA APPLICATION PROCESSES FOR CAYMANIAN STUDENTS

S tudying abroad can be a life-changing experience that will allow you to explore a new culture, build resilience and adaptability life skills that will benefit you for years. So, don't rule out applying for international programmes and scholarship opportunities.

One key factor to consider when studying abroad is that you will likely need a student visa. This article will examine the student visa application process for Caymanian students wishing to study in the US, Canada, and the UK.



US STUDENT VISA APPLICATION PROCESS The US Embassy in

Kingston, Jamaica will process your US student visa. Before beginning the visa application process, ensure you have been accepted into an American university or college.

To begin the process, you will need to create a profile at https://ais.usvisa-info.com/ en-jm/niv, and student visas are under the F category, which covers those who want to attend:

- University or college
- High school
- Private elementary school
- Seminary
- Conservatory
- Another academic institution including language training programmes.

Your student visa will be category M if you are accepted into vocational training or other non-academic training institutions.

You will need to complete the DS-160 form, which can only be completed at https:// ceac.state.gov/CEAC and once you have completed this form, you will need to print the barcode confirmation sheet. That barcode sheet will be scanned once you go into the embassy for your interview. You must complete the DS-160 form before completing the visa application process at https://ais.usvisa-info.com/enjm/niv.

You will also need to pay a student visa fee online and a Student and Exchange Visa Information System (SEVIS) fee at https://www. fmjfee.com/i901fee/index. html. Visa application fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable. The nonimmigrant visa application fee for student visas is USD \$185*.

Then you will need to schedule your consular section appointment.

For the interview:

- Arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before your appointment time.
- Queue for security screening.
- Have your fingerprints verified.
- Interview with a consular officer.

The interview is usually short, lasting around three minutes. You must convince the consular officer that you are a qualified student (your acceptance into a US university or college should show this), you are able to pay for the planned studies and that you have post-education plans.

Essential documents that you will need to carry are:

- The Form I-20 which shows that you have English proficiency, your school's official signature, SEVIS ID number and your tuition and finances (including any scholarships).
- Any scholarships documentations.
- Proof you have the funds to cover at least one year of the planned study.

If your visa is approved, the consular officer will keep your passport, the visa processing is usually done in two weeks. You will receive an email to notify you when your visa is available for pickup.

In some instances, Cayman residents applying for a US visa may be allowed to send in their passport and other visa documentation by courier instead of attending an inperson interview. You will be notified if this is an option during your application.

US student visas are valid for five years from the date of issue.



You will need a study permit if you intend to study in Canada for more than six months. Here are the documents that you will need to apply:

- Proof of acceptance from your school.
- Proof of identity in the form of your Caymanian passport.
- Proof of financial support.

You may also need a letter of explanation outlining why you want to study in Canada and understand your responsibilities as a student in Canada. If you are applying for a study permit in Quebec, you will also need a Certificat d'acceptation du Québec (CAQ), which is issued by the Gouvernement du Québec. Your school can give you all the details on applying for the CAQ.

To apply for the study permit, you must have your letter of acceptance from a designated learning institution with a COVID-19 readiness plan. You can then apply online at https://www. canada.ca/en/immigrationrefugees-citizenship/services/ application/account.html.

There are detailed instructions on how to apply on the website, please read carefully before applying:

You will also have to pay processing fees and biometrics. Study permit fees are CAN \$150, and the biometric fee is CAN \$85*. There are also thirdparty fees which can include medical exams and police certificates.

To limit the spread of COVID-19, the Consulate of Canada to the Cayman Islands in Seven Mile Beach is limiting in-person services, so call or email to find out about the necessary biometric and fingerprinting processes. Email cdncon.cayman@candw.ky or call (345) 949-9400.

The Consulate of Canada to the Cayman Islands address is:

- 1st Floor Landmark Square, 64 Earth Close, Seven Mile Beach, Cayman Islands
- The postal address is PO Box 30086, Grand Cayman, KY1-1201.

You will get your study permit at the port of entry when you arrive in Canada. Before your arrival, the government of Canada will issue you a port of entry letter of introduction that says that you are allowed to study in Canada. You will also be sent an electronic travel authorization (eTA) valid for five years or until your passport expires.

UK STUDENT VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

As a Caymanian student, you will need a Tier 4 (General) visa to study in the UK. The earliest you can apply for your student visa is six months before starting your course of study. It usually takes three weeks for you to get the visa

If you are 18 or older and studying at the degree level, you can stay in the UK for up to five years on your student visa.

It costs GBP £363* to apply for a student visa. You will also need to pay for a 'healthcare surcharge' as part of your visa application. How much you pay is dependent on how long your visa lasts. You can calculate online to find out how much this charge will be. Factors used in the calculation include your study start date, your age and if you are applying alone or with dependents, etc.

You must have an unconditional offer from a school before applying for your student visa. To prove this, you will be provided with a Confirmation of Acceptance for Study reference number. You will need to enter this number on the visa application.

You will also need to show that you have enough money to pay for your planned studies and support yourself while living in the UK. You will need to prove that you have enough money for at least one academic year.

The documents that you will need to apply include:

• A valid passport.

- Your Confirmation of Acceptance for Study.
- Proof you have enough money to cover your tuition and fees and the cost of living.

- Proof of parental consent if you are under 18.
- Written consent from your financial sponsor if you have received sponsorship.

Once you have all the necessary documents, you are ready to apply. You will need to prove your identity as part of your application process. You will have to give your fingerprint and photograph at the visa application centre in George Town at:

Genesis Close, Oceanside
Group Suite, 4th floor,
Grand Cayman

There may be an additional charge at the visa centre of £55*.

You must apply online, https://www.gov.uk/studentvisa/apply. It usually takes three weeks for a decision to be made on your visa application.

The student visa application process can be time-consuming. Please take your time and read the instructions carefully. Please apply for your student visa early.

Visa processing may change so contact the consulates and embassies when you are ready to apply for your student visa to get the most recent processes, application forms and payment details.
